## We will begin our Breakfast Club on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> May!

- P1-P7 children only at this time
- Numbers will initially be limited to first 50 children
- Children must commit to attend 5 days a week
  - It will be open from 8.10am, last entry at 8.30am
- Unless children are attending the breakfast club, no other children are permitted to enter the school grounds before 8.45am
  - Cost will be £1 per day, per child, to cover all running costs
  - Children will have the choice of cereal, toast and fruit juice
  - Families will have to book in each week via a Microsoft form- issued soon!
- Children will enter via upper gate at the nursery side and then in the canteen doors at the front reception area

• Children should pay cash directly on a Monday morning to supervisory staff at the breakfast club. Money should be in an envelope, clearly marked with the child's name and class.

### From Monday 9th May 2022:

- Start times and entry into school remain the same, gates open from 8.45am, teaching starts at 9am.
- The Nursery will finish for both classes from 1pm-1.15pm.
- Primary 1 & 2 will finish at 2pm as normal.
- Primary 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7 will all finish at 3pm.
- Children will enter and exit from the same doors as they are using now.
- Handwashing will remain in place.



# **Safeguarding Information**

I would like to take the opportunity to remind parents/guardians that no cars are permitted inside the school grounds at any time unless this has been pre-arranged with Mrs McCafferty or you are a blue badge holder. Please share this information with grandparents and childminders as refusal often causes offence. Please ensure that the school gates are kept clear. Cars should not be parked on the yellow zigzag lines outside the school gates at any time. Please talk to your child about general road safety. Please cross the road using the school crossing patrol. Enter and exit the school using the pedestrian gates only. Once your child is collected from school, please keep them beside you at all times.
