Safeguarding Information

I would like to take the opportunity to remind parents/guardians that no cars are permitted inside the school grounds at any time unless this has been pre-arranged with Mrs McCafferty or you are a blue badge holder. Please share this information with grandparents and childminders as refusal often causes offence. Please ensure that the school gates are kept clear. Cars should not be parked on the yellow zigzag lines outside the school gates at any time. Please talk to your child about general road safety. Please cross the road using the school crossing patrol.
