



December 2022 Newsletter

I am delighted to inform you that the Education Authority application portal will open on Tuesday 10th January 2023 for Nursery and Primary 1 admissions for September 2023. The admissions criteria will be published on the Education Authority website on Tuesday 13th December.

We would like to extend a warm welcome to all our prospective children along with their Parents/Guardians to our open afternoon on Monday 12th December. Our Nursery will be open from 2pm-3pm, while our Foundation Stage area (P1 & P2), will be open from 2.15pm-3.15pm. 
If your eldest child is in Primary 1 or 2 you will be allocated 2 tickets for Wednesday's show.

If your eldest child is in Primary 3 or 4 you will be allocated 2 tickets for Thursday's show.

Both performances will be held at 1.30pm. Siblings will have already enjoyed a performance of the show during dress rehearsals.

Tickets will be issued week beginning Monday 5th December.

Please note P1 & P2 children: for health and safety, as well as child protection- all children must be collected after the performances at 2.45pm from their normal collection point. P3 & P4 children should be collected at 3pm as normal.



Our Nursery children will be performing 'The Nativity' on Friday 16th December at 9.30am in the Assembly Hall. Each child in the nursery will be allocated 3 tickets for the performance. Tickets will be issued week beginning Monday 5th December. They have a full school day as normal.
