School Enrolment SEPTEMBER 2021, FAO Primary 7 & perspective Nursery & P1 children. Information on the procedures for school admissions in September 2021 should be available on the EA website eani.org.uk/parents/admissions mid- December 2020 for Pre-school (Nursery)/Primary 1 places and for post-primary places (Year 8 entry). This means parents making the application directly to EA, without involvement of school, for Nursery and Year 1. The dates given for the application process for primary and nursery schools currently is that it will go live on the EA website on the 7 January 2021, with a closing date for applications on 29 January 2021. Post-primary applications are also going online this year, rather than the traditional forms that were completed. Exact dates have yet to be given for this, but it should be during January/ February 2021. Due to Covid-19 restrictions we are unable to hold an open morning for perspective parents and children, however a virtual tour will be available on our school website and social media platforms soon-please share!
