




January 2022 Newsletter

Happy New Year! I hope that our school community had a lovely Christmas break. We have another busy term ahead of us! Thank you for your continued support of the school.




KEY DATES FOR PARENTS: Admissions Process for Primary One Places 2022

Children born on or between 2 July 2017 and 1 July 2018 will have reached compulsory school age in September Children born on or between 2 July 2018 and 1 July 2019 can apply for a place in a reception class





THE USUAL AGE GROUP OF PUPILS WHO TRANSFER TO POST-PRIMARY SCHOOL WILL HAVE ATTAINED THE AGE OF 11 YEARS BY 1 JULY 2022, I.E. PUPILS WITH DATES OF BIRTH FROM 2 JULY 2010 TO 1 JULY 2011, INCLUSIVE.

Information on the procedures for school admissions in September 2022 will be available on the EA website: www.eani.org.uk/parents/admissions on Friday 17th December 2021 for Pre-school (Nursery) and Primary 1 places. Parents/Guardians apply on-line directly on the EA admissions portal. The portal is open for applications from Monday 10th January 2022 at noon. An application will be treated as punctual if received on or before 28th January 2022 at noon. Post-primary applications are also online this year, rather than the traditional forms that were completed. I would stress the need to read the admissions criteria very carefully when making any choices. Please phone the school to discuss any questions or queries with Mrs McCafferty.

Safeguarding Information

I would like to take the opportunity to remind parents/guardians that no cars are permitted inside the school grounds at any time unless this has been pre-arranged with Mrs McCafferty or you are a blue badge holder.
